Options to address continued growth

Past Examples

→ ~~Moving 4th grade to another~~

→ Add mobiles to the site

→ Overflow new students to another school

→ Temporarily locate one grade level to another site

Boundary Decision

(LRFPC) Long Range Facility Planning Committee

- a. The LRFPC will research numerous options and their impact on Coyote Hills and Elem #42.
- b. Multiple scenarios will be presented to the community for input (May or August).
- c. All impacts will be considered, including future growth.
- d. A final recommendation will be made in October 2011.
- e. The Board of Education will make a final decision in November 2011.



VALUES

The following values guide our decision making as new school boundaries are identified.

They are not prioritized and may be contradictory.

- Maintain neighborhood school concept.
- Minimize transportation costs and maximize student walk-in.
- Use natural or manmade barriers (i.e. arterial streets)
- Maintain contiguous boundaries



VALUES

- Do not move an area that may someday need to be moved back to the original school.
- Minimize the number of boundary changes affecting a particular neighborhood.
- Boundaries should not result in any four-track school moving to a single-track calendar – just to move back on in the future
- Avoid, if possible, splitting any attendance area between two M.S.

Principal Selection

→ Position posted - January / early February

→ Screen and identify 4-6 candidates

→ Interview process

- 2-3 parents in the #42 boundary area
- 3-4 colleagues
- Identify finalists for Superintendent decision

Principal Selection

After the principal is hired...

- Identify and hire cadre of teacher leaders
- Hiring of new staff
- Creation of a shared vision / mission
- Materials selection
- Development of new school community
